# FROM YOUR PASTOR

Dear Benton and Willow Creek Congregations, I always tell people who need a spiritual hug to turn to Psalm 139. This ancient hymn of the church beautifully describes a God who is intimate with His creation, a God who knows our words even before we say them. This can be extremely comforting, or it can

be extremely disturbing to have a God so close.

George MacDonald, a Scottish novelist, poet, writer, and pastor hints at the powerful assertions of this scripture as he states: "I would rather be what God chose to make me than the most glorious creature that I could think of. For to have been thought about – born in God's thoughts – and then made by God, is the dearest, grandest, most precious thing in all thinking."

As our Bible Camps approach their last weeks of summer and counselors head back to college or other job opportunities, I give thanks for their commitment to our kids. These counselors are specifically in the camp setting to impact kids in faith, to help them experience a camp week which tries to model a Psalm 139 understanding of who we are and whose we are.

We pray that the faith seeds that were planted in the youth of the Northern Rim who attended Klein Ranch last month will grow into a thankfulness for who God has made them to be. I'm also getting ready to take five confirmation youth to Shetek in a few days. We hope and pray for the same thing – our youth are loved for who they are, born in the mind of God before they breathed their first breath! AMEN
