# Souper Bowl of Caring--Sunday, February 11th

Sunday, February 11th--In 1990, the Superbowl of Caring began with a simple prayer from a single youth group: "Lord even as we enjoy the Super Bowl football game, help us to be mindful of those without a bowl of soup to eat." Since that day, 34 years ago, more than 175 million dollars has been raised for local charities across the US through the Souper Bowl of Caring. Benton has been participating for over 26 years and we will do so again this year on Feb. 11th. Please come prepared to leave a monetary gift in the large soup kettle in the narthex. Gifts will be channeled to Feeding South Dakota, which supplies food pantries throughout SD, weekend back-pack programs for children, on-site feeding ministries, and monthly food boxes for Seniors in communities across our state.

### A few quick facts about Hunger in South Dakota and Feeding South Dakota

Every single week, Feeding SD assists in providing temporary food assistance to approximately 21,000 hungry individuals and families in SD. One out of every 6 childeran under age 18 is at risk of going hungry in SD. Almost half of the individuals served by Feeding SD are children or infants. 13.7% of SD individuals live at or below the poverty line. The Back-Pack Program of Feeding SD gives food every weekend to 5200 that otherwise may go hungry. Nearly 43% of state's school-aged children qualify for free and reduced cost meals. More than 2700 food boxes are supplied monthly to hungry Seniors. Please go to the web site: feedingsouthdakota.org for more information on how you can help. For every \$1 donated, Feeding South Dakota can provide 3 meals to individuals in need. Purchasing the same meals would cost so much more
