INTERIM PASTOR'S REPORT

As the "interim" pastor of the Benton / Willow Creek Lutheran parish, I plan and lead Sunday worship and a few other ministry items as designated by your church council. My ½ time contract allows me to finish out the confirmation year and bring Holy Communion to shut-ins, as time allows.

"Interim, by definition, means "between" – the period of time linking one fully called pastor with another.

The interim time is important for the congregation. I understand the waiting and uncertainty is not easy for most people, but the in-between time can allow the congregation to celebrate and be completed with the former pastoral leader and become ready and excited for the new pastoral leader. The task of the interim pastor is to keep the ministry going and provide space for the congregation to emotionally and spiritually let go of the former so they can embrace the new.

Calling a pastor is not like hiring a new employee. It is a time for prayer, with discerning where God is leading.

Calling a pastor is not like hiring an employee. Yes, the Call committee will review resumes and interview potential candidates, but the South Dakota Synod Bishop's office assists in connecting available pastors with vacant congregations. But the two – congregation and pastoral candidate – need to "fit". They need to match (a little bit like dating). Benton / Willow Lake can afford to pay a pastor with limited amount of experience. The parish is in a rural setting that will appeal to some pastors and not to others. Your particular ministry needs (established in your congregation's Ministry Site Profile) will limit some candidates. The Bishop's office will help pair up potential pastors that fit your church's profile with your Call Committee for interview.

Ultimately, the decision lies with the Benton / Willow Lake parish whether to Call a particular pastor or not. And such decisions are best made with lots of prayer and time for reflection.

As best I can, I will be with you in the interim time. Pastor Kent


