- 16. The basement for the Church was dug over twenty years after the church was built. The basement was excavated further in 1940 to remove a portion of the foundation to make space for the current kitchen in the basement.
- 17. The first electricity for the church building was produced on site by a 32-volt electric plant purchased by the Luther League. The church building was fully wired for electricity in 1944. The Luther League paid for the electricity in the first few years of rural electricity usage.
